

PROCEDURES FOR ENTRY TO ECUADOR AND THE GALAPAGOS ISLANDS

REQUIREMENTS TO ENTER ECUADOR (MAINLAND) AND GALAPAGOS

Since October 20, 2022, any traveler **is not required anymore** to present a **vaccination certificate** or a **negative result of a qualitative RT-PCR test performed up to 72 hours prior to boarding to Ecuador**.



Also, it's not required anymore present the Digital Traveler's Health Declaration when boarding the plane, which is available at the following link: <https://declaracionsalud-viajero.msp.gob.ec/>.

However, despite Galapagos & Ecuador new protocols, Explorer Ventures strongly encourages all guests to get tested before departing their home country.

MANDATORY MASK USE

Face mask use may be required in Ecuador and the Galapagos Islands, when indoor, so please bring your own masks that fully cover your nose and mouth (not gaiters, bandannas, etc.). Handwashing stations and gel are available in most businesses.



TEMPERATURE CHECK

You may have your temperature checked multiple times between arrival in Ecuador and arrival at your final destination in Galapagos. If your body temperature is higher than 37.9°C (100.2°F), you will not be allowed to board your flight for Galapagos. Several temperature checks can be done while onboard.
