True progress takes continuous and coordinated efforts, and we encourage you to join in by limiting your own impacts before and during your trip. We thank you in advance for helping to protect our coral reefs and oceans. Here's how you can join in!

Use Reef and Eco-Friendly Products

Please consider using (and only bringing onboard) eco-friendly and reef-safe products.

This includes sunblocks, shampoos, soaps, beauty products, and gear cleaners.



Refine Your Dive Skills

When you arrive onboard we will brief you on the best practices to reduce your environmental impact. We ask that you listen intently and when diving, look but don't touch the reef and its life.

This includes policies on the restricted use of gloves and tips for photographers.



Opt-in for Reusables

Avoid single-use plastics and waste, whenever possible. Leave these types of items at home, or take them home with you after your trip for correct disposal.

Such as plastic packaging and batteries.



Adhere to Marine Park Regulations

We operate in marine protected areas, therefore our liveboards abide by not only our own environmental regulations but also local customs and laws.

We ask that you cooperate with the laws for the best possible diving experience.



Join Reef Projects for Conservation

At home, and on board, participate in conservation projects and marine-based surveys then report your data.

If you'd like to participate during your trip, please ask the crew about our current initiatives.



Remove Plastics & Debris

During dives, you will often see our guides and crew cleaning up underwater debris. You are welcome to join in this effort anytime. Please ask the crew to brief you on the correct trash collection methods.

Better yet, grab a bag, scuba gear, and a dive buddy and do this at home!
